A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HAINES,
ALASKA, IN SUPPORT OF A SOUTHEAST ALASKA TRAIL SYSTEM
(SEATrails).

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest to provide sustainable economic opportunity for the people of Southeast Alaska; and,

WHEREAS, outdoor trails and associated businesses can provide opportunities by creating jobs that allow residents to support themselves and their families in the Southeast community of their choice; and,

WHEREAS, trails are a popular and cost-effective way to improve the health and quality of life for all the residents in a community; and,

WHEREAS, Southeast communities, by joining together in a network of coordinated trail management, could create marketing opportunities through regional maps and comprehensive information featuring those trails selected for marketing by each community; and,

WHEREAS, surface transportation is an important issue for individual communities in Southeast and for the region as a whole; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest to maximize existing and future surface transportation opportunities in these communities; and,

WHEREAS, the Alaska Marine Highway System will play a central role in Southeast Alaska, providing essential connections for a regional trail system,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Haines City Council endorses and supports the concept of the SEATrails (Southeast Alaska trails) system.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT the City Council of the City of Haines, Alaska endorses and supports the creation of a coalition of communities, governmental agencies, trail organizations and citizens to bring about the creation and promotion of the SEATrails system.
